THE GERMAN OFFSHORE MARKET

The new German chancellor and a new coalition treaty foresees a massive boost to renewable energy in general and in particular offshore wind.

Today Germany has 7.7 GW offshore wind and with Germany's decision on speeding up their renewable expansion goals, they plan to reach 30 GW by 2030, 40 GW by 2035 and 70 GW by 2045. Already awarded volume and new tenders that have started last year will lead to a strong increase in new offshore projects from 2025 onwards. Furthermore, Denmark, Germany, Netherlands and Belgium together want to expand offshore wind in the North Sea to reach at least 150 GW by 2050. This means that a lot of new projects will be established within a short period of time, which is a good opportunity for Danish offshore companies to show their innovative products.

YOUR ENGAGEMENT

It is important to be a part of the initial process and to build a strong network already now. On the offshore delegation trip you will meet German offshore companies and have the opportunity to speak with German stakeholders, which will be a good starting point for you to strengthen your network on the German market. The program consists of a three-day workshop in Germany from the 14th to the 16th of November.

The first day will take place at the Consulate General of Denmark in Hamburg, on the second day we will drive to Bremerhaven for company visits and on the third day, we will conclude the tour with further visits in Emden.

PARTICIPATION FEE

Due to subsidy programs by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Denmark, there is a 50% subsidy for SMEs.

The participation fee for SMEs is DKK 8,000 (person/company) and for non SMEs DKK 16,000 (person/company). DKK 2,500 for second person/company.
