Australian Onshore Wind & O&M Delegation - Melbourne | 1 – 5 March 2027*

Wind O&M Australia (WOMA) is Australia's leading conference dedicated to the operation, maintenance and optimisation of wind farms. The conference brings together Australian and international asset owners, utilities, OEMs, Independent Service Providers (ISPs), developers and technology suppliers, making it an ideal platform for Danish companies seeking new business opportunities in Australia's rapidly growing onshore wind market.

To maximise the commercial value of the delegation, the first two days will focus on market briefings, knowledge sharing and targeted B2B meetings with selected Australian stakeholders. During the following three conference days, Danish Energy Export will combine participation in WOMA with individually arranged B2B meetings with key Australian and international companies involved in both new onshore wind projects and the operation and maintenance of existing wind farms.
